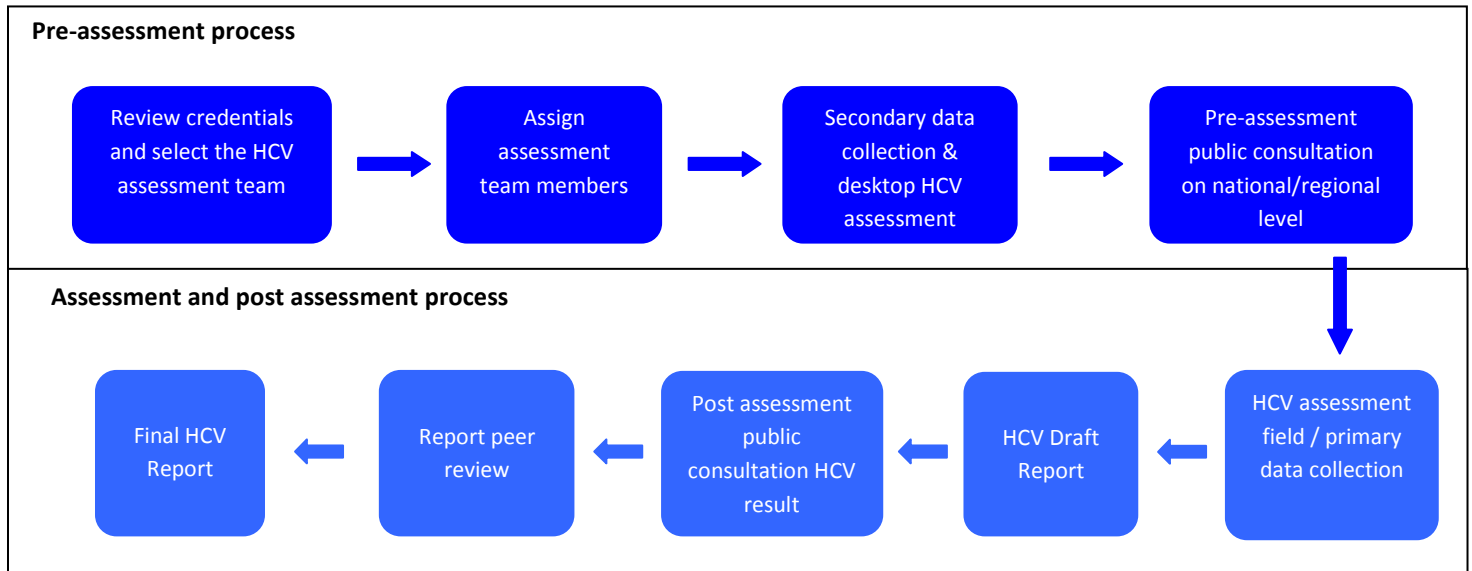


## The HCV Assessment Process

The flow diagram below details the steps required to identify HCV areas within APP pulpwood suppliers' concessions.



### Key

<b>Review credentials and select the assessment team:</b>	Assessment team selection process
<b>Assign assessment team members:</b>	Assessment team training + establish assessment protocol
<b>Secondary data collection &amp; desktop assessment</b>	Maps and other related secondary data collected. Develop field assessment plan.
<b>Pre-assessment stakeholder consultation on national/regional level</b>	Present scope and purpose of HCV assessments to stakeholders via regional public consultations. Solicit input on HCV potential from stakeholders
<b>HCV assessment</b>	Field observation, data collection, measurement and stakeholder interviews. Data analysis/observe and follow up with stakeholders
<b>HCV draft report</b>	Finalize draft HCV report including management recommendations and confirm peer review team
<b>Post-assessment stakeholder consultation on national/regional level</b>	Consultation on summary result of identified HCV with relevant stakeholders. Identification of additional HCV input and information from stakeholders
<b>HCV report peer review</b>	HCV Report peer reviewed
<b>Final HCV report</b>	The final report contains assessment team's HCV finding and monitoring & management recommendations. Including relevant peer reviewers recommendation

The results of the HCV assessment are:

1. Full HCV Report (internal document): contains detailed information which may include confidential company information
2. Executive Summary: contains summary of the HCV result with no confidential information included
3. Result of Peer Review: contains comments and recommendations from peer reviewers on the HCV report

The result of the HCV assessment will feed into the ISFMP development process.
